TO QUALIFY

- Have been a resident of Wythe or Bland County for the last two (2) years.
- Have attended a public or private high school in Wythe or Bland County for at least your junior and senior years.
- Provide an official high school transcript.

OR

- Have completed a GED by the graduation date of your original graduating class.*
- Have completed homeschool requirements or have been a homeschooled student.*

* GED and homeschool students are eligible for the program provided they meet WCC entrance requirements and other scholarship eligibility requirements.

The Wythe-Bland Foundation Scholarship Program will provide full tuition and fees not related to textbooks (after all financial aid and other scholarship funds are applied) for qualified recipients.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Eligibility is for five (5) consecutive semesters beginning with the summer or fall semester after graduation from high school.
- Qualified graduates must be US citizens or permanent residents (green card holders) of the United States and either have a social security number or ITIN to participate in the program.
- Qualified graduates are allowed to take developmental classes that are required for their chosen curriculum one (1) time.
- Checking student email and the email used for the Scholarship Application three to five times a week is important when completing the Wythe-Bland Foundation Scholarship screening process.

TO APPLY

- Complete an Application for Admission:



- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA):



- Complete the WCC Scholarship Application every Fall and Spring Semesters:



- Enroll in a degree/diploma/certificate program or an approved non-credit workforce development short-term training program.

SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE

- Complete 40 hours of volunteer service (20 hours each semester) the first two (2) semesters you receive the scholarship with an approved agency.
- Achieve a 2.0 GPA by the end of the second semester and complete 67% of all attempted classes.
- Complete a WCC Scholarship Application every Fall and Spring semester.
- Have a completed financial aid file each year.
